The Y offers after school programs, day camp programs and all day care for Tillamook School District No 9's In-service days. Program Details

Licensed Child Care Programs for entering 3-12 year olds
Before School Care

Available Monday mornings from 7:15-9. Children are transported to either East Elementary School or South Prairie Elementary School by the Tillamook School District 9 Bus System between 7:45 and 8:15. Children who attend Liberty will be escorted by foot with a childcare staff member at 9. Snack, activity tables, free play, and organized crafts are all available to help welcome children and provide a safe and friendly atmosphere for them before they start their day.

After School Care

Available Monday – Friday from 3-6. Families can choose the days children will attend, bus transportation is arranged through the Tillamook School District No 9. Daily activities include arts and crafts, supervised physical activities and games, a variety of indoor and outdoor sports, homework and reading, USDA approved meals and snacks, group swimming lessons, free swim and much, much more!

Camps and in-service days

In addition to our Before and After School Program, the Tillamook YMCA provides care for children during Tillamook School District No 9 In-Service Days, Winter Break, Spring Break, Fall Break, and Summer Camp! With daily and weekly themes, free swim, field trips, organized indoor and outdoor sports, scavenger hunts and more, your child is sure to have fun in an inclusive learning environment.

Promising Practices

- Supervision of children during non-school hours.
- Well-trained staff who are carefully screened and receive on-going training.
- USDA approved supper as children arrive from the bus system
- Fun, age-appropriate activities.
- Option of attending one day a week to five days a week.
- Contact for children with adults who listen to and respect children.
- A safe place when school is not in session.
- Participating in fun activities with a group of friends.
- Field trips
- Free Swim Friday's (Ages 7-12)
- Mini-Swim Friday's (Ages 3-6) Instructed Water Safety Classes
